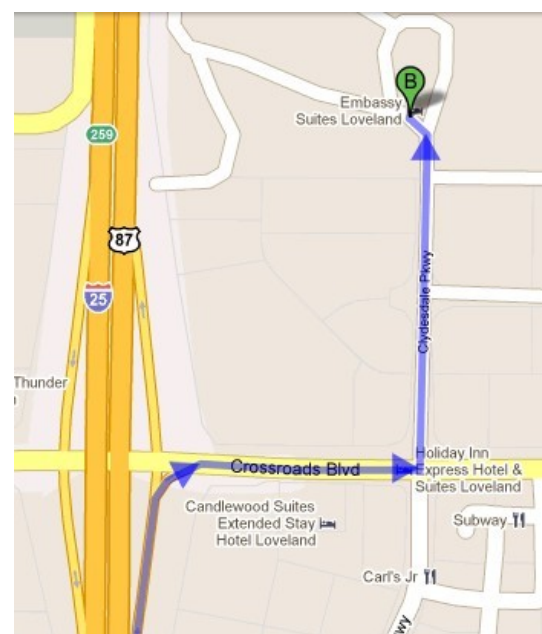
MAPS & DIRECTIONS
